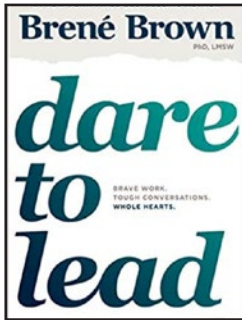

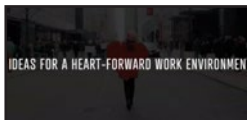


#1 Dare to Lead by Brene Brown

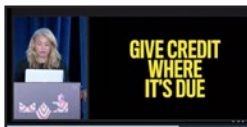
